Sergio Luciani

Sergio Luciani (Argentina) is a bonsai artist, educator, and community builder whose work has focused on expanding bonsai education and strengthening bonsai communities throughout Latin America.



For more than two decades, he has been actively involved in teaching, exhibitions, workshops, demonstrations, and international collaboration. In 2013, he founded Estudio Bonsái Argento in Buenos Aires, Argentina, which became one of the most influential educational platforms for Spanish-speaking bonsai enthusiasts, reaching thousands of students through both in-person and online programs.

Throughout his career, Luciani has participated as a demonstrator, lecturer, curator, and instructor at major bonsai events across Latin America, North America, Europe, and Asia. His commitment to education and international exchange has led to collaborations with artists, organizations, and educational initiatives dedicated to the advancement of bonsai and penjing worldwide.

In 2023, he was appointed International Consultant of the World Bonsai Friendship Federation (WBFF) and later joined the organizing team of the WBFF Photo Contest.

Luciani believes bonsai should be accessible to everyone. He often states that everyone should experience bonsai at least once in their lifetime, not only as an art form, but as a way of developing creativity, observation, and a deeper connection with nature. He advocates for educational spaces where technical knowledge and personal expression can grow together, encouraging practitioners to learn not only from trees, but also from one another.

In June 2026, he was unanimously elected President of the Federación Latinoamericana de Bonsái (FELAB) for the 2026–2030 term. Through this role, he seeks to strengthen regional integration, expand educational opportunities, and promote closer cooperation between Latin America and the global bonsai community.
